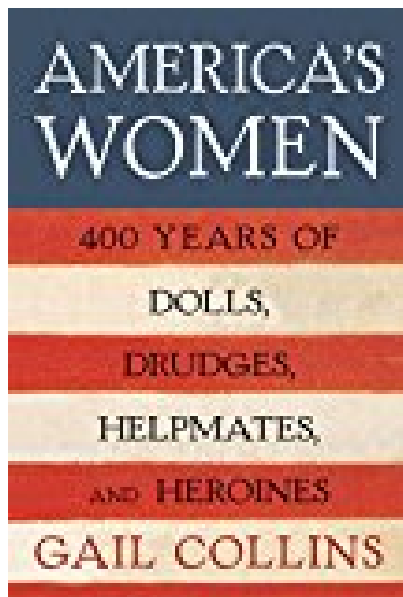

Americas Women tells the story of more than four centuries of history. While keeping her eye on the big picture, Collins still notes that corsets and uncomfortable shoes mattered a lot, too. "The history of American women is about the fight for freedom," Collins writes in her introduction, "but its less a war against oppressive men than a struggle to straighten out the perpetually mixed message about womens roles that was accepted by almost everybody of both genders." Told chronologically through the compelling stories of individual lives that, linked together, provide a complete picture of the American womans experience, Americas Women is both a great read and a landmark work of history.
